TECHNICAL PROGRAM AND AGENCY PRESENTATIONS

DISASTERS AND DISASTER MITIGATION

Disasters can be caused by nature (earthquake, hurricane, tsunami), by accident (BP oil spill) or by people on purpose (terrorism). Our responsibility, as engineers, is to apply what is learned from these events to mitigate future damage and injury. This past January, Steven Baldrige joined a team of engineers from the Earthquake Engineering Research Institute to assess the damage in Haiti caused by a 7.0 earthquake. Seven weeks later, Chile was hit by an 8.8 earthquake and subsequent tsunami. Ian Robertson and Gary Chock were on site to observe the aftermath. Steve, Ian and Gary will share their experiences and assessment of the infrastructure damages.

Additionally, we'll get a perspective from our government agencies on the social implications of disaster mitigation and expectations of designing for disaster mitigation in public works infrastructure as well as other related innovative topics. Check our website www.seaoh.org for program updates.
