

STRUCTURAL ENGINEERS ASSOCIATION OF HAWAII SCHOLARSHIP

The Structural Engineers Association of Hawaii (SEAOH) will be awarding scholarships to students entering or currently attending an accredited college or technical school as full-time students. SEAOH is planning to award \$20,000 in scholarships for 2022. The scholarships are intended to encourage Hawaii's youth to continue studying at an accredited 2-year or 4-year college or technical school.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: September 30, 2022 (Postmarked or Emailed Date) Scholarship winners will be notified in October.

Selection Criteria:

- 1. Preference will be given to the following applicants:
 - a. Members of the Structural Engineers Association of Hawaii (SEAOH).
 - b. Children of members of the Structural Engineers Association of Hawaii (SEAOH).
- 2. An applicant with highly ambitious academic pursuits will be considered more favorably, with highest consideration toward applicants studying the field of Structural Engineering.
 - Note that in keeping with the goal stated in the opening paragraph, one scholarship will be awarded to an applicant who is not planning to specifically study structural engineering.
- 3. An applicant's potential for future success will be considered in the selection by evaluating past academic performance and participation in activities that demonstrate a community-minded and well-rounded individual.

Instructions to Applicant:

- 1. Complete the application.
- 2. Attach a certified copy of your high school transcript and/or your last college term transcript.
- 3. Transmit the application using (1) of the following methods:
