

On Saturday, October 21, YMF members were given the rare opportunity to tour the Skyline's Rail Operations Center (ROC). The Skyline has been in operation for a little over 3 months and has provided residents a new

mode of transportation that will work alongside existing public transportation options like The Bus and Handi-Van. This will also allow riders to bypass any construction or traffic along the corridor.

The YMF members started the morning off with a quick introduction and background of Hitachi, who is the operator of Skyline. Then we headed upstairs and as they headed to the Operations Control Center(OCC) the tour guide a whiteboard to us that was setup like a calendar with numbers on it.

They explained to us that the trains need to be on time at a rate of 99.5% in order to get paid fully for the month. Next, we entered the OCC where Hitachi monitors the trains and helps resolve any issues quickly that may occur with the trains and even in regard to passenger safety. After a short Q&A they headed down to the

maintenance bay where the members were able to see under a rail car and were given an explanation of the safety features that are present both inside and outside of each rail car. We want to greatly thank Cara Mazzei, Jason Lurz and Tim Graham for making time for us in your busy schedules and for this opportunity. eaH meetings for December 2023 are scheduled for December 1 and 15. Details will be posted at the *eaHawaii.org* website.

At the September 22th eaH meeting, Lori Kahikina, Executive Director & CEO of HART give eaH members a complete update on HART's plans to complete the Skyline rail system. Currently, they are working on the two remaining Segments. Segment 2 – Haliawa (Aloha Stadium) to Kahauiki (Middle Street) and Segment 3 Downtown – Kahauiki to Ka'akaukukui (Civic Center). To complete the route, they had to eliminate two stations at Kaka'ako and Ala Moana. The overhead section for Segment 2 is mostly complete and remaining are the four stations. Segment 3 is the most complex because of the underground and overhead utility work that must be completed.

They still want to complete to Ala Moana and even extend to UH Manoa. But funding is of course the issue. Recently, there appeared to be a surplus of about \$500 million in the budget but that is contingent on the bids for the remaining stations coming in under or at the estimated budget amounts. If the \$500 million is available they may be able to extend, but that will still require additional funds.
