


40TH ANNUAL HAWAII STATE MATHCOUNTS COMPETITION RESULTS

The Hawaii Society of Professional Engineers (HSPE) announced the 2023 Hawaii MATHCOUNTS team on Saturday, March 25, 2023. The Hawaii team includes Coach Joseph Guillou of Iolani School and Mathletes Sola Murakami and Ethan Zee of Iolani, and Evan Ho and Keene Koide of Washington Middle School. They will represent Hawaii at the MATHCOUNTS National Competition. The four will be among 224 final Mathletes from 50 states, U.S. territories, State Department schools and Department of Defense schools, competing for the title Champion at the 2023 Raytheon Technologies MATHCOUNTS National Competition on May 13-16, 2023, in Florida.


The Hawaii team was determined at the 40th Annual Hawaii State MATHCOUNTS Competition at the Ewa Makai Middle School in Ewa Beach, HI on March 25, after intense competition between Mathletes from the Oahu, Hawaii Island and Maui MATHCOUNTS Chapters, which included seven finalist schools, and 52 finalist Mathletes. These 52 elite Mathletes all had a chance of competing for a Hawaii Team spot and a trip to the National. The ten highest scorers as a result of combining scores from the Sprint and Target Rounds competed in the Countdown Round with the top four Mathletes from this round making the Hawaii team. The ten competing students listed by total scores in the Sprint and Target Rounds, included in tenth place Noah Shin Punahou, ninth place Haru Greene of Iolani, eighth place Daniel York of Washington Middle, seventh place Irena Xu of Iolani, sixth place Alex Hudson of Iolani, fifth place Evan Ho of Washington, fourth place Yongwoo Kang of Washington, third place Keene Koide of Washington, second place Ethan Zee of Iolani, and in first place Sola Murakami of Iolani.

These top ten Mathletes competed in the Countdown Round in a single-elimination tournament style, head-to-head, oral round starting with the tenth and ninth place Mathletes. The math problem is read and shown on a screen and the Mathletes are given 45 seconds to answer. Calculators are not allowed. The first to press the buzzer answers first, and if wrong, the other Mathlete has the rest of the 45 seconds to answer. In the earlier matches, the first to answer more problems correctly after at least two problems are presented moves on to meet the next higher placed Mathlete. In the final three matches, the first Mathlete to answer three problems correctly moves on.

The placement of teams is determined by adding team members' individual scores from the Sprint and Target Rounds plus the Team

Round score. Of the seven competing teams, in first place was Iolani School, and therefore Coach Joseph Guillou, for the second year in a row, has the honor of being the Hawaii Team Coach at the National in Orlando, Florida. Second place to seventh place schools, respectively, were Washington Middle School with coach Sung Park, Punahou School with coach Yun Choe, Seabury Hall and coach Conner Mullen, Mililani Middle School with coach Geri Hamada, Highlands Intermediate School and coach Deborah Nakagawa, and Paauilo Elementary and Intermediate School and coach Michael Shumate.

Our distinguished Awards presenters included Patricia Ishihara, State Mathematics Specialist, Hawaii Department of Education; Robyn Au, Chief Counsel, Honolulu District, US Army Corps of Engineers; Abigail Haneke, Maui Chapter Director, National Society of Professional Engineers; and Barry Nakamoto, President, Hawaii Society of Professional Engineers Educational Foundation. The organizations they represent have a major role in perpetuating MATHCOUNTS in Hawaii.






Speaker: Bill Bonnet – 1977 Past President and Retired Hawaiian Electric Executive

Topics:

Underground Atomic Testing: where, when, and why. The tunnel complexes and individual tunnel design. A short tutorial in header and bench tunneling and the art of drill and blast techniques. Bill's personal experience in the summers of 1962 and 1963.

Operation Plowshare: potential peacetime uses of atomic blasting and the role of the Sedan Shot (last surface test) in that program. Description of the North American Water and Power Alliance as a prospective application.

The Rover Program: objective was to design and build a nuclear reactor which could be used as a rocket engine. Phases of the program: Kiwi (reactor design), and NERVA (test stand design and construction). Difficulty of using liquid hydrogen as both coolant and propellant. Metallurgy (temperature gradient) challenges associated with a reactor core next to almost absolute zero liquid hydrogen. Unique constraints in construction of a test stand in a radioactive environment. Bill's observations from the summer of 1964.
